

Globe-trotting runners

RICHARD Ginn travelled to Estonia to take part in the Tallinn Marathon and recorded a fast time of 3:04:20, coming 76th overall giving him a superb 12th place in his category.

Stuart Evans participated in the Alderney half-marathon on the Channel Islands in hot and sunny conditions. Stuart had an excellent result coming in 12th in a time of 106:47.

Closer to home, Mike Pullon ran the Robin Hood marathon in a warm and windy Nottingham. Mike was disappointed with his time of 3:50:48 but was glad to finish, despite suffering with pains in his feet from 11 miles.

Lockington staged the popular Major Stone half-marathon with a strong head wind causing the run-

ners a few problems. Helen Cross was 13th overall, and the second woman to finish, in a time of 85:11, then Steven Worth who was 19th in 89.10, Simon Rycroft overcame tight hamstrings to finish 26th in 92:10, just ahead of Stuart Smith, who was making a strong return from injury, in 92:23. Alan Kendra struggled over the last six miles but still came 36th in 94:01, Adele Shipley fought off the effects of a cold to finish just outside a PB in 70th place, in a time of 104:49, which gave her second in category and Sue Vicary was 104th in 118:44.
